YES, CHEFI

Competing under pressure taught me quick problem solving and creativity which are essential traits for a chef.

Key differences:

- Training & experience: Chefs have deeper training and often years of experience.
- Responsibility: Chefs manage the kitchen and staff; cooks focus on preparing dishes.
- Creativity: Chefs innovate and create recipes; cooks follow established methods.
- Title: "Chef" implies higher skill and leadership in the kitchen.

In short, cooks are vital to daily kitchen operations, but chefs lead, innovate, and shape the culinary vision.
